In the Name of God, the Compassionate, the Merciful

The Triumph of Logic, Will, and Resistance over Force and Arms

It took only forty days for the United States regime to yield to the resistance, will, and logic of the Islamic Republic of Iran. Had this regime not fallen prey to the miscalculations and traps of the Israeli regime prior to its aggression against Iran, such a war would never have occurred. If the U.S. government had studied the history of Iran and the indomitable spirit of its brave people, we would not be witnessing the massacres, destruction, the collapse of international law, and war crimes currently perpetrated by the leaders of the American and Israeli regimes.

Forty days were enough for the American regime to submit to Iran's demands and realize that the great people of Iran cannot be addressed in the language of threats. In this short period, America has come to understand that an imposed regional order cannot be sustained.

Forty days were sufficient for a "New Iran" and an "Iran-centered Middle East" to gain global credibility, and for the world to witness geopolitical and geoeconomics transformations with Iran at the center.

These changes are evident and verifiable through the following ten principles. Examining these principles clearly demonstrates the emergence of a new Middle East, a sovereign legal framework for the Persian Gulf, the collapse of the oppressive "maximum pressure" mechanism, the invalidation of peace imposed by force, and—most importantly—the awakening of global public opinion and its rejection of the destructive policies of major powers. These principles have been Iran's consistent demands for the past forty-seven years; after forty days, the American regime was finally compelled to accept them as the basis for negotiations.

The Ten Principles:

- A fundamental commitment by the United States to guarantee non-aggression.
- Continued Iranian sovereignty and control over the Strait of Hormuz.

- Recognition of Iran's inherent right to enrichment.
- Removal of all primary sanctions.
- Removal of all secondary sanctions.
- Termination of all UN Security Council resolutions against Iran.
- Termination of all IAEA Board of Governors resolutions.
- The payment of reparations to Iran.
- The withdrawal of U.S. combat forces from the region.
- The cessation of war on all fronts, including against the heroic Islamic resistance in Lebanon.

It is hoped that the American regime, moving forward, will not again fall victim to the miscalculations of the Israeli regime, and will prioritize the interests of its own people over those of the Zionist regime.
